### Grant Funding Overview

### Grant Focus Areas

Grant funding is intended to support programs and projects that:

- Benefit youth and education
- Promote stable housing and community development
- Support arts and cultural enrichment
- Address clearly defined community needs with measurable outcomes

### Eligibility

To be considered for funding, applicant organizations must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a qualified nonprofit organization, including those recognized as 501(c)(3) entities or other eligible nonprofit classifications
- Operate programs that directly serve Riverside and/or San Bernardino Counties
- Have been in continuous operation for a minimum of three (3) years
- Demonstrate financial stability and provide a current operating or project budget
- Submit requests that support established or clearly defined programs
- Be able to articulate measurable goals and outcomes for the proposed use of funds
- Be in good standing with applicable state and federal regulatory agencies
- Submit applications that align with the mission, focus areas, and charitable objectives of the Provident Savings Bank Charitable Foundation

The Foundation does not fund requests for political activities, individual assistance, or expenses unrelated to programmatic impact.

- **December Funding Cycle:** Applications accepted from **June 2 through December 1**

**Application deadlines are June 1 and December 1, annually.**

**Notification of Awards:**

Applicants will be notified of funding decisions in **July** or **January**, following the Foundation's Board meeting.
